<p><u>Making Predictions</u></p> <p><u>Teaching Points:</u> -Predict a story. -Identify the role of an author in a story.</p> <p><u>Teach/Model:</u> Create an anchor chart with the students' predictions from the story.</p> <p><u>Active Engagement:</u> Create a list of predictions from the story. Were the students' predictions correct?</p> <p><u>Closure:</u> Have students share if their predictions were correct.</p>	<p><u>Ice Skating</u></p> <p><u>Teaching Points:</u> -Identify the first through fifth positions in a line of objects.</p> <p><u>Teach/Model:</u> Pretend to ice skate- share experiences of skating.</p> <p><u>Active Engagement:</u> Activity 1- Put animals in order from first to fifth position. Activity 2- Decorate a pair of ice skates.</p> <p><u>Closure:</u> Share what students learned about ordinal positions.</p>	<p><u>Making Patterns</u></p> <p><u>Teaching Points:</u> -Create AB, AAB, and ABB patterns. -Describe the position of objects.</p> <p><u>Teach/Model:</u> Introduce the vocabulary words "excitement" and "contained".</p> <p><u>Active Engagement:</u> Activity 1: Create AB, AAB, and ABB patterns. Activity 2- Use a "present" to practice positional words.</p> <p><u>Closure:</u> Have students share what they learned about patterns and positional words.</p>	<p><u>Winter Adventures</u></p> <p><u>Teaching Points:</u> -Create a blank book about winter adventures. -Label and write complete sentences.</p> <p><u>Teach/Model:</u> Create a list of winter adventures on an anchor chart.</p> <p><u>Active Engagement:</u> Students will create a blank book about winter adventures.</p> <p><u>Closure:</u> Share the blank books with a partner.</p>	<p><u>Let's Bake</u></p> <p><u>Teaching Points:</u> -Use drawings and writing to describe the job of a baker.</p> <p><u>Teach/Model:</u> Create an anchor chart with keywords describing the job of a baker.</p> <p><u>Active Engagement:</u> Write a sentence about something they would bake for the holidays.</p> <p><u>Closure:</u> Share the drawings with a partner.</p>

<p><u>Cheetah Research</u></p> <p><u>Teaching Points:</u> -Research cheetahs -Describe the habitat of a cheetah. -Describe how cheetahs can protect themselves.</p> <p><u>Teach/Model:</u> Model the expectation for research (using Pebble Go or informational books).</p> <p><u>Active Engagement:</u> Research information on cheetahs.</p> <p><u>Closure:</u> Share a new fact that students learned</p>	<p><u>Let's Compare</u></p> <p><u>Teaching Points:</u> -Compare the length and weight of objects. -Comparing numbers.</p> <p><u>Teach/Model:</u> Explain how students will compare in the activities.</p> <p><u>Active Engagement:</u> Activity 1- Comparing using ice skates. Activity 2- Comparing objects.</p> <p><u>Closure:</u> Share what students learned about comparing</p>	<p><u>BME</u></p> <p><u>Teaching Points:</u> -Retell a story from beginning to end. -Identify the setting of the story.</p> <p><u>Teach/Model:</u> Divide students into groups to retell the story.</p> <p><u>Active Engagement:</u> Write and draw the beginning, middle, and end of the story.</p> <p><u>Closure:</u> Share the BME sheets with a partner.</p>	<p><u>Snowball Fight</u></p> <p><u>Teaching Points:</u> -Recognize and produce rhyming words. -Count and segment syllables.</p> <p><u>Teach/Model:</u> Review rhyming words and syllables.</p> <p><u>Active Engagement:</u> Activity 1- Snowball fight with rhyming words. Activity 2- Syllable Ice Skating.</p> <p><u>Closure:</u> Share their favorite part of the games.</p>	<p><u>Winter Celebration-5K</u></p> <p><u>Teaching Points:</u> -Class Celebration for Annabelle's Best Winter Ever.</p> <p><u>Teach/Model:</u> Teachers will have a winter celebration. Students will share what they learned about reading and completing the lessons.</p> <p>*Station ideas are included.</p> <p><u>Closure:</u> Share their favorite activity from the story.</p>
